Subject: Checking/Verification of Original Certificate/Documents for admission to PG Medical/Dental Courses, Session 2020.

Sir/Madam,

The Process of Admissions to PG Medical/Dental courses has been started by the University. The online centralized counselling is carried on as per Punjab Govt. Notification No. 5/26/2016-5HB-III/1121 dated 14.02.2020 and the Schedule of online counselling is as under:

1. The last date for receipt of online application including NRI applications is curtailed from **31.05.2020 to 19.04.2020.**
2. The Provisional Merit List will be displayed on the website of University (www.bfuhs.ac.in) upto **21.04.2020.**
3. The candidates will inform the objections if any in the provisional merit list by **22.04.2020 upto 5.00 PM.**
4. Candidates including NRI candidates will fill/submit the online choice of speciality/college from **24.04.2020 to 26.04.2020.**
5. The result of 1st round of online counselling will be declared by **29.04.2020.**
6. Last date for joining / reporting is 04.05.2020.
7. All the colleges are requested to provide the link to their website and Email ID (on which the candidates will upload the documents) to the University.

The provisionally selected candidates will report for joining to the respective colleges as under :

The last date for joining/reporting shall be notified on website / provisional allotment letter
3) Physical Reporting

The candidates would report to the college physically for taking admission, after paying necessary fees through RTGS/NEFT to the account of university and submission of the original documents at the college and start duties.

4) Online Reporting

They can join the allotted college by sending a confirmatory email regarding acceptance of seat and uploading scanned copies of relevant documents as mentioned in important questions related to scheme of counseling and pay the requisite fees through RTGS/NEFT to the account of university, notified on university website.

Colleges are requested to create / provide Email ID on their website so that students will upload the documents in case of online reporting.

1. The Principal of the concerned College shall constitute the committee from amongst the faculty members, to verification of original documents/checking of eligibility of the candidate as per the Punjab Government Notification No 5/26/2016-5HB-III/1121 dated 14.02.2020 and University Prospectus for admission to PG courses – 2020. The following documents (Check List) are required for Physical/Online Reporting for verification by the College authorities:
 - i) Admit card issued by NBE
 - ii) Result/Rank Letter issued by NBE.
 - iii) Mark Sheets of MBBS/BDS 1st, 2nd & 3rd Professional Examinations.
 - iv) MBBS/BDS Degree Certificate/Provisional Certificate.
 - v) Internship Completion Certificate/Certificate from the Head of Institution.
 - vi) Permanent / provisional Registration Certificate issued by MCI or DCI/State Medical or Dental Council.


- vii) High School/Higher Secondary Certificate/Birth Certificate as proof of date of Birth.
- viii) The NOC from competent authority in case of PCMS candidates.
- ix) Candidates allotted seat must carry one of the identification proofs (ID Proof) to the allotted college at the time of admission (as mentioned in the information Bulletin published by the National Board of Examinations (NBE) for AIPGMEE/AIPGDEE i.e. PAN Card, Driving License, Voter ID, Passport or Aadhar Card.)
- x) The following reserve category certificates and respective college will get these certificates cross verified from the Welfare Department.
 - a. SC/BC Certificate issued by the competent authority of Punjab.
 - b. BC certificate issued by the competent authority of Punjab. The BC certificate must be in the format as mentioned in the prospectus.
 - c. Disability Certificate issued from duly constituted and authorized Medical Board for 21 Benchmark Disabilities as per the Rights of Persons with Disability Act, 2016 as mentioned in the Information Bulletin for National Eligibility-cum-Entrance Test (Post Graduate) NEET-PG-2020. No other PWD certificate, issued by any other Authorities/ Hospital will be entertained.
 - d. The EWS certificate issued by the competent authority of Punjab.
- xi) The undertaking mentioned in the Prospectus as Annexure B or Annexure C.
- xii) The SGRD Medical/Dental Colleges, Amritsar and CMC/CDC Ludhiana will verify the eligibility of Minority Quota candidates as per terms and conditions of their institute. In case the candidates opt for online reporting, the final decision regarding eligibility for Sikh Minority status will be decided at the time of physical reporting by SGRD Medical/Dental College, Amritsar.
- xiii) PG candidates who were selected through All India 1st Counselling under NEET PG 2020 will have to resign from All India Quota seat and they will submit the proof of resignation of All India Quota seat in the allotted college at the time of joining.
- xiv) Proof of deposition of six months fee alongwith UTR Number to the Registrar, BFUHS, Faridkot through RTGS/NEFT online mode in the university account.

The college will get the hand written self attested undertaking from All the candidates in the following format in the respective college at the time of joining :

4. That I was selected through All India Quota counselling in the _____ college in the _____ speciality.

 5. That I was selected through State Quota counselling (other than Punjab) in the _____ college in _____ speciality in _____ State.
OR
 6. That I was not selected in any college in any counselling of All India / State.
- xv) Hand Written and Self Attested Undertaking by the candidate stating as under:-

"I hereby declare that all the information given/uploaded by me in the application is factually correct and true to the best of my Knowledge and belief. I undertake that in the event of any information being found false or incorrect at any stage, my candidature is liable to be cancelled and I will have no claim on the seat allotted to me by the competent authority".

2. All admissions made online will be deemed Provisional, to be confirmed subject to **verification of documents** at the time of physical joining.
3. Those candidates who will not report in the allotted college upto the due date, their allotted seats will be treated as cancelled (as not joined) and no claim will be considered thereafter for that seat.
4. The concerned colleges will inform the university about the candidates who have not reported/not joined by the due date/time.


Registrar
